

Thal Sainik Camp: 20th july'16 onwards.

The TSC is a 12 days camp conducted in Delhi every year in the late autumn, in which the cadets are selected from all 16 directorates (30+3 cadets from each directorate), by the selection procedure conducting 3 pre-TSC camps each of 10-12 days in a weeks interval. The selected cadets then are sent to the TSC. Our cadets Abhimanyu P.S. Chauhan, Sanjeev and Vibhuta Trivedi attended the Pre Tsc-1 cadre.











All India Trekking Expedition Camp, Uttrakhand: 14th September'16 to 22nd September'16.

- One of the most prestigious adventure activity camps of NCC
- Trekking expedition spanning Ranibagh, Haldwani, Ratighat, Bhujan and Nainital in Uttarakhand
- Cadets of 7DBN represented Delhi Directorate in the National Camp. 5 cadets of DCAC NCC participated
- Prizes Delhi Directorate stood first in Volleyball match organised during the camp







Pre-Republic Day Camp, Cadre-1: 3rd Nov'16 to 13th Nov'16.

Pre-RDC camps are selection camps where on the basis of drill and cultural performance cadets are selected through a 10 day long selection procedure and send to further stages of selection. Cdt. SUO Kaustubh Rana, Cdt. Cpl. Vibhuta Trivedi, Cdt. Satish Kumar, attended the camp.

Advance Leadership Camp(ALC): 9th Jan'17 to 21st Jan'17.

It is aimed at inculcating leadership qualities amongst cadets and to acquaint them with Service Selection Board (SSB) process to join arm forces. Six Advance Leadership Camps (ALC), are conducted every year, which a total of 1350 cadets attend to focus on personality development, leadership skills and orientation for induction into the Armed Forces. Our Cadet NCO, Cdt. Cpl. Vibhuta Trivedi, attended ALC, where he gained a lot of valuable insight on ssb screening. He got all India Ranking-15th in the camp and was won lots of appreciation from officers.
